Directions to our new meeting location

St. Josephs Parish Center, 68 Central Street, Auburn


From Worcester and north:

- 1. Exit I-290 southwest-bound at Auburn Street in Auburn
- 2. At the end of the ramp, turn left onto Auburn Street
- 3. Cross Route 12 (Southbridge Street) and keep going straight on Auburn Street until the light at the intersection directly beneath the elevated Mass Pike
- 4. Bear right onto Central Street
- 5. About a half mile, the sign for St. Josephs Parish Center will be on the right. Turn right and go uphill to the parking area.

From Auburn and south:

- 1. In Auburn, Exit I-290 at Swanson Road (northeast-bound) and turn right
- 2. At the light, cross SR 12 (Southbridge Street) and go straight across. Road bends to the left next to Auburn Mall
- 3. At the end of the road, turn right onto Auburn Street
- 4. Drive down Auburn Street until the light at the intersection directly beneath the elevated Mass Pike
- 5. Bear right onto Central Street
- 6. About a half mile, the sign for St. Josephs Parish Center will be on your right. Turn right and go uphill to the parking area.


Directions to our new location

St. Josephs Parish Ctr, 68 Central St., Auburn

Alternate Route from within Auburn:

- 1. In Auburn, from intersection of Rt. 12 and U.S. Rt. 20, travel north on Rt. 12 (Southbridge Street)
- 2. After the driving range (on right), just before Rt. 12 goes under the Mass Pike, turn right onto Church Street
- 3. Follow Church Street to the end, and take a left onto Central Street
- 4. The entrance to St. Josephs Parish Center will be on your left after a quarter mile
- 5. Turn left and go uphill to the parking area.
- 6. Meeting will be inside you can take the ramp up to the door.
