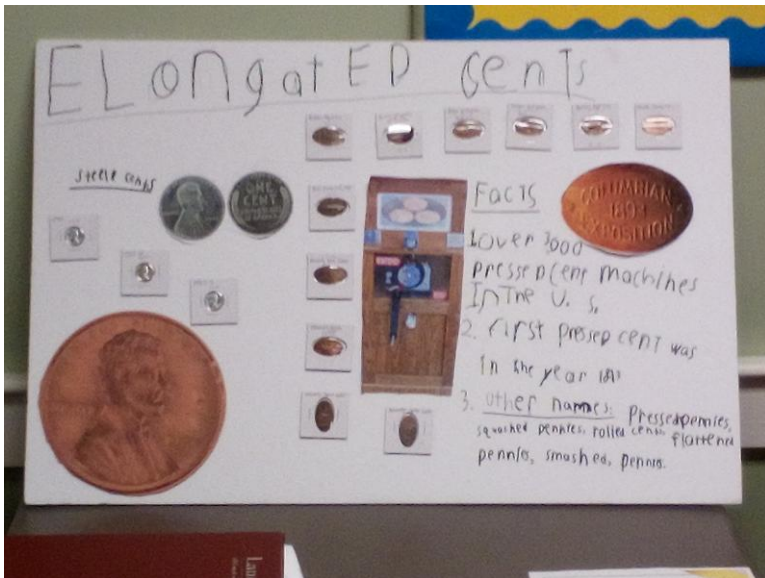
October's Meeting 🗣️ :
